St Marylebone CE School for girls is looking for a reliable and enthusiastic Food and Textiles Technician to join its Design and Technology department in its brand new Blandford Street building. If you have a good knowledge of food and cooking, enjoy working with young people as well as being part of a happy team and have a hard-working, flexible approach to work then this could be the perfect job for you.

As well as supporting the pupils and teacher in the classroom during food technology lessons you will be responsible for making sure the classroom is organised and clean and set up appropriately before each lesson. Shopping for ingredients as well as ordering dried goods in bulk and kitchen utilities will be a regular part of the job as well as keeping account of the department finances. Regular cleaning and washing as well as deep cleaning is also a big part of the job so you need to be the sort of person that is happy to get your hands dirty! Other duties will vary depending on the requirements of the department therefore a 'can do' attitude would be warmly received.

Possession of a basic food hygiene certificate would be desirable but not essential (although a willingness to attend a one day course would be essential) as would previous professional cooking experience and basic first aid. We will run a new CRB for you to begin this post in September.
